Re: Snowboard Park

All Students - Required

Rosseau Lake College has through donations, purchased and constructed, a modest snowboard park consisting of:

- 1) A “drop in” ramp approximately 16 feet high
- 2) Multiple metal rails: rainbow rail, battleship, straight. Of varying heights – one-foot to five-feet and lengths of eight-feet to thirty-feet.
- 3) Multiple boxes: wood and plastic construction, varying heights
- 4) Ramps (jumps): these vary in height from one-foot to four-feet.
- 5) Quarter pipe: curved section constructed primarily of wood.

It is important to note that:

- ✓ RLC students are responsible for maintaining the park and outside of sports time the park is unsupervised
- ✓ The area is lit for use after dark.

During the winter months RLC students who would like to use these facilities either formally during sports or during their free time must have their parents sign this consent form. The students are welcome to use the equipment but as parents and guardians, you should be aware that there is risk involved with snowboarding and snowskating. Injuries can occur! Please complete the following consent form or denial of permission to your child’s participation in these activities please do so by printing this form out signing it and return it to Rosseau Lake College by **July 30th**

Rules

- 1) Students must have this consent form signed by their parents.
- 2) Students must sign this consent form themselves.
- 3) Students must stay within their own abilities and limits.
- 4) Students must not encourage others to attempt maneuvers beyond their abilities.
- 5) Students must put safety above all other considerations at all times, this includes such rules as:
 - ✓ Wearing a proper ski/snowboard helmet
 - ✓ No inversions ever (flips, going upside down). No exceptions!
 - ✓ Walking up the side of the course, getting out of the way when finished one’s run.
 - ✓ Only one skier/snowboarder on the drop-in at any time
 - ✓ Waiting for a clear run
 - ✓ Wearing proper ski and snowboard clothing,
 - ✓ Using properly maintained equipment for purposes that it is intended for.
 - ✓ No toboggans, snowskates, snow blades, etc on the drop-ins, elevated rails, jumps etc.
 - ✓ Snowskates are to be used in the snowskate area only
 - ✓ Foul language, boisterous play, or purposeful damage to the park will lead to suspension of the privilege of use
 - ✓ Any action or activity that puts other students at risk or diminishes their enjoyment of the park.

Location

The park is located on the slope of the hill between the Dining Hall and the Headmaster's residence.
