Medical Coverage Information

It is important that your son or daughter has medical coverage in the event of an accident or major illness. The Ministry of Health requires temporary residents in Ontario to confirm this coverage before coming to Canada.

In conjunction with other Ontario Independent Schools, Rosseau Lake College has negotiated private coverage for international students. The coverage mirrors OHIP and is called **Medi-Select Advantage**.

International students who come to Ontario to study are not eligible for provincial paid health coverage unless they are Canadian citizens and have a permanent residence in Ontario.

It is mandatory that all non-landed, international students enrolled at Rosseau Lake College, have medical insurance coverage with Medi-Select Advantage.

When a student requires a medical appointment while in residence at the school, the School Nurse will ensure that the necessary forms for reimbursement of medical expenses are completed and submitted to the insurance company.

If a student receives medical treatment while on weekend leave or on holiday from Rosseau Lake College it is the student's or guardian's responsibility to ensure the appropriate forms are completed by the doctor and/or the hospital for reimbursement of the cost from the insurance company. When students visit a medical facility other than the facilities used by Rosseau Lake College, they will be expected to pay for the medical service before medical treatment is given. The student must ask for a written and signed document outlining the treatment and the cost, which can then be submitted to the insurance company for reimbursement.

If a student has a major medical problem during the school year, it will be necessary for the parents to immediately mail a deposit to the student's account to cover the medical expenses. Rosseau Lake College will not be responsible for any medical expenses for students enrolled at the school.

It is extremely important that your child has medical coverage before his/her arrival in Canada. An insurance card will be issued to your son or daughter early in the fall term.

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Procedure to Apply for Medical Insurance Coverage at Rosseau Lake College

1. complete the *Medi-Select Advantage* application form –
Please sign the “Medical Authorization and Declaration” area on the form
2. complete the section on the bottom of this page
3. include a cheque, money order or credit card number and expiry date. Please make the cheque/money order payable to Rosseau Lake College OR complete the credit card section at the bottom of this form.
(Please refer to the enclosed *Medi-Select Advantage* brochure for the Premium Schedule)

(Rosseau Lake College will submit payment, application forms, and proof of enrollment to the insurance company on your child’s behalf)

4. include a copy of your study permit or a copy of your passport. **If you are unable to provide this before your arrival at the school, please ensure a copy is submitted as soon as possible.**
